### 3. Overgrown hedge on local path no. 5

An update from ERYC indicated that of 24 households contacted 8 had indicated that they did not wish to accept responsibility for the maintenance of the hedge and that guidance was being sought on whether the number of responses received was sufficient to take action to remove the hedge.

## 4. Dog fouling

The Chair reported that the school had indicated that it was hoped that the ERYC presentation to the school children would take place in November.

Certificate of lawfulness for continued use of building in connection with livery business at Willow Toft Farm Owstwick Road Dantorpe - 17/03076/CLE

Continued use of former function room as two flats at Black Horse Inn Main Street Roos - 17/03104/PLF

Continued use of Dual Doppler Radar system in relation to monitoring wind speed and complex wind flow patterns for the existing Westermost Rough offshore windfarm at Pastures Lane Tunstall - 17/03280/PLF

Cllr Cracknell reported that she had been made aware of health concerns which may be linked to the existing radar system and it was agreed in principle to raise no objections to the application but to highlight these concerns to ERYC.

Erection of detached garage following demolition of existing garage at 12 Elm Garth Roos

Erection of two storey extension to side and associated alterations at Butterfly Cottage 1 North end Road Roos

It was reported that ERYC had approved the above two applications.
